2011 has been a very big year for the stop the intervention campaign. A lot of work has been done in communities, town camps and major cities to expose the reality of the intervention. The intervention has meant the loss of Aboriginal control of communities and local councils, cuts to remote jobs and services, and punitive measures like income management and new work for the dole arrangements.

Communities across the NT have been calling for an end to the intervention, but the government refuses to listen. The government has twisted its recent consultations so it can say there is widespread support for the intervention to go on. Next week Indigenous Affairs Minister Jenny Macklin will bring in new laws to keep the intervention past its 5 year expiry date.

We need to work together to plan the next stage in our fight. Come along to this planning meeting and talk with other community people about the struggle for Aboriginal rights.
